

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 25, 26, 27.

Chap. 25. AN ACT RELATIVE TO PREVIOUSLY ABANDONED SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY BY MEMBERS OF THE METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 27 the following section:-

Section 27A. Notwithstanding the provisions of section ten or sixteen of this chapter to the contrary, any community which takes all its water from the metropolitan water district and upon so taking said water, abandoned a former source of water supply may cause to be investigated said abandoned or unused source of supply for the purpose of determining the suitability of use as an alternative source of supply for either potable or non-potable uses. If in the course of said investigation, the community determines that the use of said water, whether potable or non-potable, is desirable and attainable, said community shall be allowed to reactivate said water for use.

Chap. 26. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER THE CONNECTICUT RIVER ON INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 391 CONNECTING THE CITY OF CHICOPEE AND THE CITY OF HOLYOKE AS THE VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The bridge over the Connecticut river on interstate highway Route 391 connecting the city of Chicopee and the city of Holyoke shall be designated and known as the Vietnam Veterans Memorial bridge in recognition of the significant contribution to the nation and the commonwealth rendered by Vietnam veterans. The department of public works shall erect a suitable marker bearing said designation in compliance with the standards of said department, and as authorized by the federal highway administration.
