AN ACT DIRECTING THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN PHARMACY TO PREPARE A LIST OF CERTAIN DRUGS AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The board of registration in pharmacy shall prepare a list of
- 2 the most commonly used prescription drugs, not to exceed one
- 3 hundred drugs, and shall, before September thirtieth in the cur-
- 4 rent year, issue regulations for the posting, displaying or other-
- 5 wise furnishing to patrons, by every pharmacy, such list together
- 6 with the prices charged by such pharmacy for such standard
- 7 quantities of the listed drugs as shall be determined by the board.
