RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE INCREASING COST AND DECLINING QUALITY OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 *Resolved,* That a special commission, to consist of three
- 2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
- 3 tatives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
- 4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and
- 5 study relative to the increasing cost and declining quality of
- 6 health care services and the methods whereby such health care
- 7 services may be improved.
