In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE STATE PRIMARY ELECTION DAYS AND STATE BIENNIAL ELECTION DAYS AS LEGAL HOLIDAYS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 53, section 28, of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence after the first
3 paragraph: — “All state primary election days preceding biennial
4 state elections shall be designated as legal holidays in the
5 Commonwealth.”

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 54, section 62, of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence: — “All
3 biennial state election days shall be designated as legal holidays in
4 the Commonwealth.”
