AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SEALING OF RECORDS UPON A NOT GUILTY FINDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 100C of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 322 of the acts of 1973, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the word "terminated", in line
4 thirteen, the words: — or a finding of not guilty has been entered.
