AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMONWEALTH ASSUME THE EXPENSES OF THE JUVENILE COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 58 the following section: —
3 *Section 58A.* The juvenile courts shall, respectively, receive,
4 examine and allow account for all salaries, supplies and services
5 incident to their operations, and order payment thereof out of the
6 treasury of the commonwealth. There shall annually be expended
7 out of the treasury of the commonwealth, upon the certificate of
8 the justices of the respective juvenile courts, such sums as may be
9 appropriated therefor.
