The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE COMMONWEALTH OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF FROM PURCHASING FISH FROM FOREIGN SOURCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 30P the following section:—
- 3 *Section 30Q.* The commonwealth and every county, city, town,
- 4 district, commission or other public body shall not purchase or
- 5 use any fish from foreign sources.
