AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN APPLICATIONS FOR REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENTS PUBLIC RECORDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 59 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 831 of the acts of 1974, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 If an abatement is granted under this section, the application
5 therefor shall become a public record and shall be made available
6 for inspection by members of the public during usual business
7 hours.
