RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO INDUSTRIAL TAX EXEMPTIONS AND EMPLOYMENT AND ALL OTHER RELATED MATTERS THERETO.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of
3 representatives, and four persons to be appointed by the
4 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
5 investigation and study relative to industrial tax exemptions and
6 employment and all other related matters thereto. In the course of
7 its investigation, said commission shall consult with the executive
8 office of manpower affairs.
