RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE TAX STRUCTURE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represent-
3 atives and four persons to be appointed by the governor, three of
4 whom shall be municipal officers, is hereby established for the
5 purpose of making an investigation and study of the tax structure
6 of the commonwealth.
