official ballot at such election:- "Shall an act passed by the general court in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled 'An Act providing for recall elections in the Town of Lunenburg' be accepted?" If a majority of the votes cast in answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall take effect, but not otherwise.

Chap. 68. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR NOMINATIONS BY PRELIMINARY ELECTIONS OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIVE MUNICIPAL OFFICES IN THE CITY OF LEOMINSTER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2.02 of Article II of chapter 543 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Preliminary elections shall be held in the city of Leominster in accordance with the provisions of sections forty-four A to forty-four G, inclusive, of chapter forty-three of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to all municipal elections held in the city of Leominster on or after January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

Chap. 69. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CEMETERY COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LITTLETON TO REFUND MONIES TO CERTAIN PURCHASERS OF BURIAL RIGHTS IN THE TOWN CEMETERY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of sections nineteen and forty-three C of chapter one hundred and fourteen of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the cemetery commissioners of the town of Littleton are hereby authorized to refund monies paid by any person for the purchase of burial rights in the town cemetery when such person or his heirs and assigns conveys said burial rights back to the town.
