Chap. 80. AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR FALSELY CLAIMING TO BE A VETERAN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 43A of chapter 56 of the General Laws, as amended by section 30 of chapter 393 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Any violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars.

Chap. 81. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF PROPERTY DAMAGE NECESSARY FOR THE MANDATORY REPORTING OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first sentence of section 26 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 628 of the acts of 1965, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "two" and inserting in place thereof the word:- five.

Chap. 82. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF PARLIAMENTARY LAW MONTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15PP, inserted by chapter 63 of the acts of 1980, the following section:-

Section 15QQ. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the month of April as Parliamentary Law Month and recommending that said month be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.

Chap. 83. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING CERTAIN PUBLIC MEETINGS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 5A of chapter 66 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 323 of the acts of 1964, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "twenty-three A" and inserting in place thereof the word: - twenty-three B.

Chap. 84. AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF HOSPITAL TRUSTEES TO MANAGE THE PUBLIC HOSPITAL OF THE TOWN OF DANVERS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 13 of the acts of 1949 is hereby amended by striking out section 26 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 26. Appointment of Hospital Trustees.- The town manager shall appoint eleven suitably qualified persons as trustees to manage the public hospital of the town of Danvers. Three of said persons shall be appointed for a term of one year, four for a term of two years, and four for a term of three years; and annually thereafter there shall be appointed by the town manager, members of the board of trustees for a term of three years in the place of those members whose terms are to expire. The trustees shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified. If for any reason a vacancy should occur, the town manager shall forthwith fill the vacancy for its unexpired term. The trustees appointed hereunder shall organize for the proper conduct of their duties. In the performance of their duties, the hospital trustees shall be subject to the general supervision and direction of the town manager. They shall be
