AN ACT RELATIVE TO A CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR STATE POLICE DETECTIVES SERVING IN ANY DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 State Police Detectives appointed under section 6 of chapter 22
2 of the General Laws and serving in any division of the department
3 of public safety shall be granted an allowance of \$300.00 per year,
4 to be paid quarterly, to compensate them for wearing civilian
5 clothing during the performance of their duties.
