Chap. 96. AN ACT INCREASING THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF BOARD OF HEALTH REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 31 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 285 of the acts of 1937, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 11, the word "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the words:- two hundred.

Chap. 97. AN ACT INCREASING THE FINE FOR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO MINORS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The second sentence of section 34 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 193 of the acts of 1980, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 17 and 18, the words "two hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words:- one thousand.

Chap. 98. AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO BORROW MONEY FOR COMPUTER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 7 of chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after clause (27), added by section 3 of chapter 628 of the acts of 1981, the following two clauses:-

(28) For the development, design, purchase and installation of computer hardware, other data processing equipment and
