RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO INSTITUTING A COMPETITIVE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represent-  
3 atives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and  
5 study of the feasibility of instituting a competitive motor vehicle  
6 insurance program based on the State of New Hampshire's "fiscal  
7 responsibility" statutes, while retaining "no fault" personal injury  
8 and adding availability of under insured and uninsured motorist  
9 protection.
