AN ACT MAKING THE DISTRICT COURT OF LEOMINSTER, THE DISTRICT COURT OF WINCHENDON, THE DISTRICT COURT OF LEE, AND THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF BERKSHIRE AT ADAMS FULL TIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 78 of chapter 218
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 14 of chapter 558 of
3 the acts of 1974, is hereby amended by striking out in line 6 the
4 words: — district court of Leominster and by striking out in line
5 11 the words: — fourth district court of Berkshire and by striking
6 out in line 14 the words: — district court of Lee and by striking
7 out in line 18 the words: — district court of Winchendon.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 77A of said
2 chapter 218, as appearing in section 12 of chapter 558 of the acts
3 of 1975, is hereby amended by inserting after the fourth line the
4 following lines: — fourth district court of Berkshire district court
5 of Lee and by inserting after the fifty-sixth line the following two
6 lines: — district court of Leominster district court of Winchen-
7 don.
