

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 132, 133.

SECTION 8. Section 51 of said chapter 130, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Violations of any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars.

Chap. 132. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE FORFEITURE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN DRUG RELATED CASES.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide for regulating the forfeiture of certain property in drug related cases, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 47 of chapter 94C of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after subparagraph (6), added by section 3 of chapter 669 of the acts of 1981, the following subparagraph:-

(7) No forfeiture under this section shall extinguish a security interest held by a creditor in a conveyance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the trustees of Mount Wachusett Community College are hereby authorized and directed to name the physical education complex
