

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 156, 157.

General Laws.

SECTION 64. Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect or alter the validity of any investment or any amount loaned or invested under the provisions of any applicable chapters of the General Laws in effect immediately prior to the effective date of this act.

SECTION 65. Sections twenty, twenty-three, thirty-nine A and forty-one shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.

Sections five, nine, twenty-nine, forty-six, forty-seven, forty-eight, sixty and sixty-four shall take effect whenever, pursuant to P.L. 94-200 Title I Sec. 102, the federal law controlling the deposit interest rate differential as set forth in clause (a) of said Sec. 102 is eliminated or repealed, or April first, nineteen hundred and eighty-six, whichever occurs first.

Chap. 156. AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INCLUDE THE WORDS "NEW BEDFORD" ON CERTAIN STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE SIGNS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to include on signs for state highway route 24 located both northbound and southbound on state highway route 128 immediately preceding the intersection of said route 128 and said route 24 the words "New Bedford".

Chap. 157. AN ACT PROVIDING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR BRISTOL COUNTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the current appropriation act for Bristol county, the following

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the treasurer of Bristol county is hereby authorized with the approval of the county commissioners, to expend the total amount appropriated in section one from any available funds, including federal revenue sharing funds, in the treasury of said county.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 158. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The office of chief of police of the town of Franklin shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the civil service status of any person holding the office of chief of police in the town of Franklin.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
