Chap. 172. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF AGENT OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The position of agent of the board of health in the city of Gloucester shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 173. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF CERTAIN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES BY SCHOOL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 47 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, as appearing in chapter 271 of the acts of 1954, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- All receipts by the committee in connection with the conduct of activities provided for under this section or any other activity not expressly provided for in this chapter but sponsored by the school committee in which participation is contingent upon the payment of a fee by the participant, shall be deposited with the treasurer of such town or, in cases where the town is a member of a regional school district, with the treasurer of such district and held as a separate account and expended by said school committee without further appropriation, notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter forty-four.
