AN ACT PROMOTING ALTERNATIVE SOURCES OF ENERGY FOR HOME AND INDUSTRIAL USE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the cities and towns of the Commonwealth shall
3 not, for a period of five years, increase the assessed valuation of
4 any real property, on which the owner(s) thereof have installed
5 equipment for the heating and/or electrical supply of said
6 property utilizing energy from solar, wind, or water power.

1 SECTION 2. The cities and towns of the Commonwealth shall
2 deduct from the taxes due on any real property, the amount
3 incurred by the owner(s) of such property for the installation of
4 equipment for the heating and/or electrical supply of said
5 property, for the tax year in which such explanation takes place.
