**Chap. 225. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNT OF RETIREMENT BENEFIT WHICH MAY BE PAID BY THE RELIEF ASSOCIATION OF THE LYNN FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The Relief Association of the Lynn Fire Department, a corporation duly established under chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the General Laws, is hereby authorized, upon the retirement from the fire department of the city of Lynn of any member in good standing, to pay to such member such sum, not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, as may be determined by vote of said corporation. Any amount paid in accordance with this provision shall reduce the death benefit otherwise available upon the death of such member.

**Chap. 226. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED TOWN OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 108 of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 166 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- The salary and compensation of all elected officers of a town shall be fixed annually by vote of the town at an annual town meeting, but said salary or compensation may be revised by a two-thirds vote of any special town meeting called to conduct business later in the same fiscal year for which said salary or compensation was originally fixed; provided, however, that such salary revision
