RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE NAMING OF ROUTE 140 IN THE CITY OF GARDNER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That the Department of Public Works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of the
3 subject matter of current house document numbered 4117,
4 directing the department of public works to designate Route 140
5 in the city of Gardner as the Honorable Cyrille P. Landry
6 memorial highway. Said department shall report to the general
7 court the results of its investigation and study, and its
8 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
9 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the
10 same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before
11 the first Wednesday of April, 1977.
