AN ACT PROVIDING THAT POLICE AUTHORITIES NOTIFY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS INVOLVING FATALITIES AND SERIOUS INJURIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 29 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the seventh sentence the following
3 sentence:

4 The police department having jurisdiction over the place on the
5 way where such accident occurred shall notify the registrar
6 forthwith of any fatal accident or accident involving serious
7 injury.
