AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SUPPORT OF SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby

3 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section a city or town
4 may, by a two-thirds vote of the city council and by a two-
5 thirds vote at the annual town meeting, respectively, reduce
6 or strike any item in the budget of the school committee.
