RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS TO ENACT LEGISLATION PROVIDING CERTAIN WARNINGS OF VIOLENT BROADCASTS.

Resolved, That the Congress of the United States is hereby memorialized to enact legislation directing the Federal Communication Commission to include in its regulations a requirement that broadcasters must provide the viewing public with the following twenty-second announcement by both visual and audio means preceding all television programs other than sporting events which depict scenes of violent behavior against human beings:

“WARNING: THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM CONTAINS SCENES OF VIOLENT BEHAVIOR AGAINST HUMAN BEINGS.”

of the House a similar provision is contained in section 317 of title 18, U. S. Code, which provides for the same as to the House. It is therefore suggested that the same provision be inserted in the bill.

The Administration of the Bill
