

Accompanying the fifth recommendation of the Department of Correction (House, No. 31). Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN PERSONS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE POSITION OF CORRECTION OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 125 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 152, chapter 835 of the acts of 1974 is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the third paragraph and inserting
4 in place thereof the following paragraph:—
5 In accordance with civil service laws and rules the division of
6 personnel administration shall certify the names of applicants
7 from an established list for correction officers to the commissioner
8 who shall appoint said applicants as correction officers any
9 temporary correction officer who was not afforded a civil service
10 examination during his continuing term of service prior to the age
11 of thirty-five shall be eligible to take such examination after the age
12 of 35 and in accordance with civil service laws and rules the
13 division of personnel administration shall certify these names of
14 applicants from an established list for correction officers to the
15 commissioner who shall appoint said applicants as correction
16 officers. Newly appointed correction officers who have not
17 successfully completed training as correction officer trainees shall
18 be assigned to a period of training as the commissioner shall
19 prescribe. Notwithstanding any civil service law or rules, a
20 correction officer must serve a probationary period of nine months
21 before becoming a full-time permanent employee of the depart-
22 ment. Time spent in training shall be considered a part of the
23 probationary period.
