Dear Secretary Guzzi: Enclosed is the Departmental legislation for 1978, consisting of:

1. AN ACT TO AMEND THE POWERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING OVER THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF DAMS.
2. AN ACT TO AMEND THE WETLAND PROTECTION ACT WITH REGARD TO MAINTENANCE DREDGING.
3. AN ACT TO MAKE CERTAIN TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL RECODIFICATION OF 1975.
4. AN ACT TO REQUIRE APPROVAL FOR THE SITING OF SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANTS FOR DISTRICTS.
5. AN ACT ENABLING THE COMMISSIONER OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING TO DESIGNATE EMPLOYEES WHO MAY ISSUE PERMITS, LICENSES, ORDERS OR AUTHORIZATIONS.
6. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HAZARDOUS WASTE BOARD.
7. AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CHARGES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS TO MAJOR AIR POLLUTION SOURCES, AS REQUIRED BY THE CLEAN AIR ACT AMENDMENTS OF 1977.
