

Accompanying the sixth recommendation of the Department of Public Safety (House, No. 146). Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9L of Chapter 22, of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following
3 paragraph:—

4 “The commissioner of public safety may promulgate rules and
5 regulations relating to proper standards of skill and the type of
6 equipment, including uniforms, utilized by such appointees.”

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 10K the following section :—

3 Section 10L. The commissioner of public safety may
4 promulgate rules and regulations relating to proper standards of
5 skill and the type of equipment, including uniforms, utilized by
6 special police officers licensed by him under the provisions of
7 section 10, 10A, 10B, 10C, 10D, 10E, 10G, 10H, 10I, 10J, and 10K
8 of this chapter.
