## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SECOND FULL TIME JUSTICE IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN ESSEX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 6 of Chapter 218 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most  
3 recently amended by Chapter 254 of the Acts of 1976, and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 Each district court other than the municipal court of the City of  
6 Boston, shall have one justice, except that the district court of  
7 Brockton, the second district court of Bristol, the third district  
8 court of Bristol, the district court of Springfield, the municipal  
9 court of the Dorchester district, the first district court of eastern  
10 Middlesex, the first district court of southern Middlesex and the  
11 district court of Southern Essex shall have two justices each, and  
12 the municipal court of the Roxbury district, the third district court  
13 of eastern Middlesex and the central district court of Worcester  
14 shall have three justices each.
