

HOUSE No. 317

By Mr. Craven of Boston, petition of the Massachusetts Association of Contributory Retirement Systems, Inc., and James J. Craven, Jr., that military service performed by certain public employees be considered as creditable service for purposes of retirement. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MILITARY SERVICE PERFORMED BY CERTAIN EMPLOYEES BE COUNTED AS CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR PURPOSES OF RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4, Chapter 32, of the General Laws, as amended is
- 2 further amended by adding the following paragraph:
- 3 Any member who is a veteran as defined in Section (1) having
- 4 not less than twenty years creditable service in the Commonwealth
- 5 or any of its political subdivisions shall be granted creditable
- 6 service up to four years for military service performed.
