**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMONWEALTH SHALL REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS AND DISTRICTS FOR THE STATE-WIDE PER PUPIL AVERAGE COSTS OF EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to reimburse every city, town and district the state-wide  
3 per pupil average cost incurred for education in public schools, and  
4 adequate appropriations shall be made annually by the general  
5 court to carry out the provisions of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to costs incurred for the  
2 school years commencing in September in the current year, and for  
3 all subsequent school years.
