By Mr. Scaccia of Boston, petition of Angelo M. Scaccia for legislation to require school transportation of children in areas determined to have hazardous travel conditions. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION OF CHILDREN WHERE IT IS DETERMINED THAT DANGEROUS TRAVEL CONDITIONS EXIST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 68 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 1 of chapter 97 of the acts of 1934, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following sentence: — If the area between a
4 child's residence and the school he is entitled to attend has been
5 determined by the local school department to have hazardous
6 travel conditions then the department shall be required to furnish
7 transportation to such child and the cost shall be reimbursable
8 from the state.
