

By Mr. Scaccia of Boston, petition of Angelo M. Scaccia that persons sixty five years of age and older be charged a reduced rate for use of certain state facilities. Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL STATE AGENCIES ASSESS PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER A REDUCED CHARGE FOR USE OF FACILITIES WHERE CHARGES FOR SUCH USE ARE IMPOSED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 16A of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 862 of the acts of 1970, is hereby  
3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 The commonwealth shall charge persons sixty-five years and  
5 older who reside in the commonwealth one half the regular adult  
6 charge for use of any state facilities including any facilities  
7 operated by the metropolitan district commission or the  
8 department of public works provided that such persons shall first  
9 obtain an identification card from the executive office of elder  
10 affairs at no cost to the applicant upon the furnishing by the  
11 applicant of evidence reasonably sufficient to establish said age.
