AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TIMELY NOTICE OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION RESULTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is amended by inserting in
- 2 Section 12 the words "not later than one hundred and twenty days
- 3 after the date of such examination" between the word "thereof"
- 4 and the period in the sixth sentence of the first paragraph.

In the Senate, by yeas 27, nays 17, passed July 20, 1870.
