Chap. 382. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REFUNDING OF CERTAIN BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES BY THE TOWN OF TEWKSBURY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The treasurer of the town of Tewksbury, with the approval of the selectmen of said town, is hereby authorized to issue bond anticipation notes of the town in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding one million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars maturing not later than October twenty-second, nineteen hundred and eighty-three for the purpose of paying and refunding the one million seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars aggregate principal amount of sewer bond anticipation notes of the town originally dated October twenty-second, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, January twenty-third and April first, nineteen hundred and eighty and February twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, all of which notes are now payable on October twenty-second, nineteen hundred and eighty-two. Notes issued under this act which mature earlier than October twenty-second, nineteen hundred and eighty-three may be renewed or paid from time to time by the issue of other notes, provided that the maturity of any note issued to renew or pay the same debt shall not be later than October twenty-second, nineteen hundred and eighty-three. Notes issued under this act may be converted into a serial loan in the same principal amount.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Lenox is hereby authorized to issue a license for the sale of all alcoholic bever-
