RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SECRETARY OF EDUCATION RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRANSITIONAL BILINGUAL ACT OF 1971 AS IT PERTAINS TO CERTAIN CAPE VERDEAN IMMIGRANT COMMUNITIES.

1 *Resolved*, That the secretary of education is hereby authorized
2 and directed to make an investigation and study relative to the
3 implementation of the Transitional Bilingual Education Act of
4 1971 as it pertains to Cape Verdean immigrant communities in
5 Boston, Scituate, Brockton and New Bedford.
6 Said secretary shall report to the general court the results of its
7 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
8 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
9 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or
10 before the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and
11 seventy-eight.
