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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO REPORTING OF BURNS CAUSED BY FIRE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after Section 12A, the following new paragraph:—

3 Every physician attending or treating a case of burns caused by  
4 fire, whenever such a case is treated in a hospital, sanitarium, or  
5 other institution, shall report said injury to the manager,  
6 superintendent or other such person in charge thereof, and said  
7 manager, superintendent or other person in charge shall report  
8 such a case, at once, to the Commissioner of Public Safety of the  
9 Commonwealth, the Police Department and the Fire Department  
10 of the community where such a hospital, sanitarium or institution  
11 is located.

12 Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished  
13 by a fine of not less than fifty dollars and not more than one  
14 hundred dollars.
