Chap. 390. AN ACT ESTABLISHING CIVIL SERVICE STATUS FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Those employees of the school department of the town of Braintree who are classified as maintenance personnel shall be subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 391. AN ACT VALIDATING A CERTAIN QUALIFYING OATH OF OFFICE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eleven of chapter thirty of the General Laws or of any other general or special law to the contrary, Joseph M. Duffy of the town of Clinton having been appointed a member of the civil service commission is hereby authorized to take and subscribe the oath required to qualify him for said office before the town clerk of the town of Clinton.

SECTION 2. The qualifying oath taken and subscribed by said Joseph M. Duffy before Earl Wilson, town clerk of the town of Clinton, on April twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and eighty is hereby validated, confirmed and is effective as though this act was in effect at the time said oath was taken; and any acts performed by him in his official capacity, are also hereby validated and confirmed.
