providing a more rapid amortization of principal. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the limit prescribed therefor by section ten of chapter forty-four of the General Laws but, except as provided herein, shall be subject to the applicable provisions of said chapter forty-four. The officers authorized to issue bonds or notes hereunder may enter into such agreements as may be required or permitted under the federal law and regulations governing said Coastal Energy Impact Program.

SECTION 2. Receipts from the operation of the project financed hereunder shall be reserved for appropriation and may be applied to the payment of charges and expenses incident to the maintenance and operation of the waterfront facilities of said city, or to the extension, improvement or replacement thereof, to the payment of interest on bonds or notes issued hereunder, or to the payment or redemption of such bonds or notes, provided that any sums remaining unexpended for such purposes after the close of any fiscal year may be used to reduce the tax levy of said city.

SECTION 3. The action taken by the city of Fall River under an order of the city council in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-two is hereby validated and confirmed to the same extent as though this act had been in full force and effect at the time said order was adopted.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 407. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER OF BRISTOL COUNTY TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO COPY PRODUCTS, INC.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven teen of chapter thirty-four of the General Laws, or of any other special or general law to the contrary the county treasurer of Bristol county, to fulfill a moral obligation, is hereby authorized to pay out of the treasury of said county the sum of two thousand two hundred sixty-eight dollars to Copy Products, Inc., for the rental of a copy machine to the Fall River district registry of deeds in the county of Bristol for the period from

May first, nineteen hundred and eighty to July thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, inclusive.

SECTION 2. No bills shall be approved by the county commissioners of said county or paid by said treasurer under authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said treasurer stating under penalties of perjury that the goods and services for which said bill was submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said county and that such goods and services were rendered to said county.

SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate required by section two, which is false, and who thereby received payment for goods and services which were not received by or rendered according to the statements required by said section shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars, or both.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 408. AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND  
A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE MASSACHUSETTS TRIAL COURT  
AND THE MIDDLESEX SUPERIOR COURT  
OFFICERS ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 191 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended by inserting after item 1599-3315 the following item: -

1599-3322 To provide for the cost of salary adjustments and other employee economic benefits authorized by the collective bargaining agreement between the Massachusetts trial court and the Middlesex Superior Court Officers Association; provided, that the commissioner of administration is hereby authorized to transfer from the sum provided to other items of appropriation such amounts as are
