AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWER AND DUTIES OF CONSTABLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41, Section 92 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 237 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby amended by
3 striking out section 92 and inserting in place thereof the
4 following:—

5 *Section 92.* A constable who has given bond to a city or town in
6 the sum of not less than \$25,000, with sureties approved by the city
7 council, board of aldermen or selectmen, conditioned for the
8 faithful performance of his duties in the service of all processes
9 committed to him, and has filed the same, with the approval of the
10 city council, board of aldermen or selectmen endorsed thereon,
11 with the city or town clerk, shall serve and execute within such city
12 or town all precepts lawfully issued to him and all other processes
13 required or permitted to be served by an officer.
