AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the seventh paragraph and inserting in
3 place thereof the following paragraph:—

4 No person, firm, corporation, association or other combination
5 of persons, directly or indirectly, or through any agent, employee,
6 stockholder, officer or other person, or any subsidiary whatsoever,
7 licensed under the provisions of sections eighteen or nineteen shall
8 be granted a license under this section.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

Article I. Of the Legislature.

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of six members, who shall be chosen by the electors of the several counties, and shall hold office for two years.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen by the electors of the several counties, and shall hold office for one year. The number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every five thousand inhabitants, and shall not be less than thirty.
