AN ACT AMENDING THE SECOND-HAND MOTOR VEHICLE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-four G of Chapter ninety of the
2 General Laws as appearing in Chapter two hundred and sixty-six
3 of the Acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section 57 of Chapter 140 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting in line seven after the word "parts"
3 the following words: — " , or a scrap processor"

1 SECTION 3. Section 58 of said Chapter 140 is hereby amended
2 by striking out Class 3 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following: —

4 Class 3. Any person whose principal business is the buying of
5 second hand motor vehicles for the purpose of remodeling, taking
6 apart or rebuilding the same, or the buying or selling of parts of
7 second hand motor vehicle parts, may be granted a motor vehicle
8 junk license.

9 Class 4. Any person whose principal business is a scrap
10 processor who purchases material which may have been a vehicle
11 or vehicle part, but who does not sell any such material as a motor
12 vehicle, a trailer or a major component thereof, may be granted a
13 motor vehicle salvage license.
