## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE TWO ADDITIONAL, REVERSIBLE LANES ON THE SOUTHEAST EXPRESSWAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, the
- 2 Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to
- 3 plan, design and reconstruct the Southeast Expressway providing
- 4 for the use of two reversible lanes in the center of said expressway
- 5 for the purpose of meeting peak traffic volumes inbound and
- 6 outbound on said expressway.
- 7 For that portion of the expressway where said reversible lanes
- 8 are in effect there shall be no means of entering or leaving said lanes
- 9 other than the origin and terminus.
