AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SCHEDULING OF THE APPROPRIATE FEE TO BE PAID TO THE STATE UPON FILING FOR A LICENSE AS A TEMPORARY JUNIOR ASSISTANT INSTRUCTOR UNDER THE LAW REGULATING THE REGISTRATION OF HAIRDRESSERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 87CC of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting the following position: —
- 3 Temporary Junior Assistant Instructor License \$15.00.
