AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL POSITIONS OF THE BUREAU OF NUTRITION EDUCATION AND SCHOOL FOOD SERVICES ON THE SAME STATUS AS OTHER PROFESSIONAL POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 622 of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-one or chapter 435 of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and fifty-three or any other acts to the contrary,
4 the positions of Educational Specialist I, Educational Specialist II,
5 Educational Specialist III and Educational Specialist IV in the
6 bureau of nutrition education and school food services shall be
7 exempt from the provisions of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as
8 amended. Provided, however, that any incumbents who have been
9 permanently appointed to such positions on the effective date of
10 this act shall retain their Civil Service status. However, their
11 successors to such positions shall not be subject to the provisions of
12 chapter 31 of the General Laws, as amended. Future incumbents to
13 these positions shall be approved by the board of education on
14 recommendation of the commissioner of education.
