

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 459, 460.

(a) Any person who knowingly or intentionally manufactures, distributes, dispenses, or possesses with intent to manufacture, distribute or dispense a controlled substance in Class A of section thirty-one shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than ten years or in a jail or house of correction for not more than two and one-half years or by a fine of not less than one thousand nor more than ten thousand dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Chap. 459. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROCKTON TO USE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF CONSERVATION LAND FOR PARK AND RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 249 of the acts of 1981 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 11 to 14, inclusive, the words "Northerly by Pearl Street 170 feet, more or less; Westerly by Plot 44-1 Pearl Street, 417 feet, more or less; Southerly 238.8 feet; and Easterly 412 feet, more or less, by Plot 43 Pearl Street to the point of beginning." and inserting in place thereof the following words:- Southerly by Torrey Street 550 feet more or less; Westerly and Southerly by a right of way on a remaining portion of said Plot 45 Pearl Street 350 feet more or less; Northwesterly by Plots 24 and 23-1 Torrey Street on said Plan, 370 feet more or less; and Easterly by the remainder of Plot 45 Pearl Street, 630 feet more or less.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 460. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF EMPLOYEES OF THE LYNN WATER AND SEWER COMMISSION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

ACTS, 1982. - Chap. 461.

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 381 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs:-

Every employee who immediately prior to being transferred to the commission by this section is a member of the Lynn contributory retirement system established under chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, or predecessor retirement systems thereto, shall continue to be a member thereof and subject to the laws applicable thereto. All other employees of the commission shall be required to become members of the Lynn contributory retirement system in the same manner and subject to the same laws, rules and regulations as persons entering the employ of the city. The commission shall deduct from the wages of its employees and pay over to the Lynn retirement board such sums as the city would deduct and pay over if such person were an employee of the city.

The commission shall reimburse the city for its proportionate share of any amounts expended by the city under the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws for retirement allowances to or on account of employees of the commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 461. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SCITUATE TO SELL A PORTION OF A PARCEL OF LAND ACQUIRED BY THE TOWN FOR PARK AND OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Scituate is hereby authorized to sell and convey, for the sum of two thousand seven hundred and twelve dollars, a portion of the old railroad right of way in the North Scituate section of said town, bounded and described as follows:-

Northwesterly by Hollett Street, 17.43 feet;

Northeasterly by land of Town of Scituate, formerly of New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad Company, 128.17 feet;

Southeasterly by land of Richard T. Cresswell, 17.09 feet;

Southwesterly by other land of said Cresswell, 127 feet;

Containing approximately 2,106 square feet;

being a portion of the land acquired by the said Town of Scituate
