AN ACT TO PROVIDE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO RECIPIENTS OF GENERAL RELIEF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2, Chapter 117 is hereby amended by inserting after
2 Section 1, the following section:

3 *Section 1A.* The Department shall furnish medical assistance
4 by making payment therefor to the person or institution supplying
5 medical care or services, on behalf of all persons who receive cash
6 assistance under this section. Such medical assistance shall include
7 payment for all medical care and services.
