## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 1012 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting after the word "delinquents" the words:—  
4 "or to any court officer of the district courts or the municipal court  
5 of the city of Boston,"

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

As amended by the Thirteenth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, and Nineteenth Amendments

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
