AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MINIMUM COMPENSATION UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 530 of the acts of 1955, is further
3 amended by adding the following subsection: —

4 (g) Notwithstanding any foregoing provisions of this section, or
5 any other general or special law or rule pertaining thereto to the
6 contrary, the director whenever in his discretion the public interest
7 would be benefited thereby, may promulgate rules and regulations
8 establishing minimum levels of compensation based upon family
9 need.
