AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE COMMONWEALTH TO ASSUME THE ENTIRE COST OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the
